Bullying

The Board of management take allegations of bullying extremely seriously and the school is proactive in dealing with such allegations. The Anti-Bullying Policy is reviewed annually. We welcome any feedback on the policy which can be viewed on our Website.

Please contact the school as soon as you have a concern in order for the staff to deal with behaviours of concern at the earliest opportunity. The children complete at least three surveys during the year. These surveys will be re-titled **Raising Awareness.** These surveys give the children the opportunity to bring concerns or worries (either about themselves or indeed another child) to the staff's attention .

School Self evaluation

The School will focus on Oral language (English and Gaeilge) in the coming Academic year. A pilot program with 3rd and 4th Classes will be established between Gaelscoil an Ghoirt Álainn (Montenotte). The children will team up with their peers to develop language fluency and conversational skills in both English and Gaeilge.

Swimming and Gymnastics

The Aquatics programme will return in 2022/2023 for children from 1st to 6th Class.

A Gymnastics Programme will be introduced for all classes next Year.

Forest School

The BoM have taken a decision to pause Forest School next year. This is largely due to financial constraints as swimming and gymnastics will incur a cost for parents.
