

Following a meeting of the Board of Management on December 2nd, 2020

It has been noted that Senior Infants will remain in school until 1:30pm and Junior Infants will remain in school until 1:40pm from January on.

Much work has been done to highlight the Road Safety concerns on Grattan Street. Following many emails and phone calls to the City Council and an email campaign to City Councillors, the zebra crossing lights were fixed on 12<sup>th</sup> October.

New road painting is to be carried out and the possibility of removing/moving poles to allow for greater visibility of the zebra crossing flashing lights. Also, further warning signs are to be sourced and installed. The Board are actively looking to get a Lollipop person for the Zebra crossing.
